#### **Republican:**

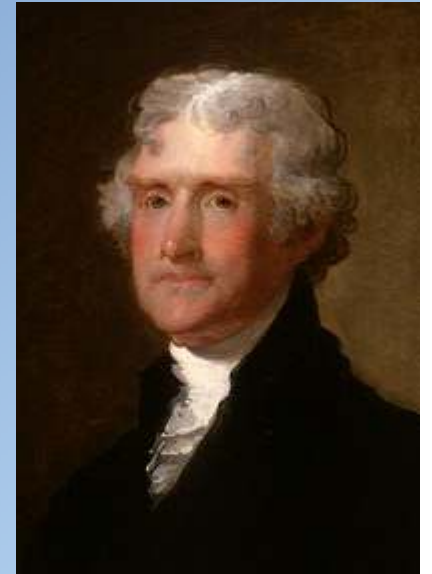
**Pardon men held under Sedition Act**

**Reduce Government  
civil service**

**army and navy** (but established USMA)

**Abolish taxes – except tariff**

**Pay down national debt** (but borrowed for LA purchase)

**killed Hamilton in duel (1804)**

**LA conspiracy (1807)**

**Arrested, confined at Ft. Stoddert**

**Found not guilty of treason**

Marbury v. Madison, 1803

William Marbury had been appointed a Justice of the Peace of the District of Columbia by President John Adams under the Judiciary Act of 1800. When Thomas Jefferson became President in 1801, Marbury's commission had not been delivered, and James Madison, Jefferson's Secretary of State, refused to do so.
