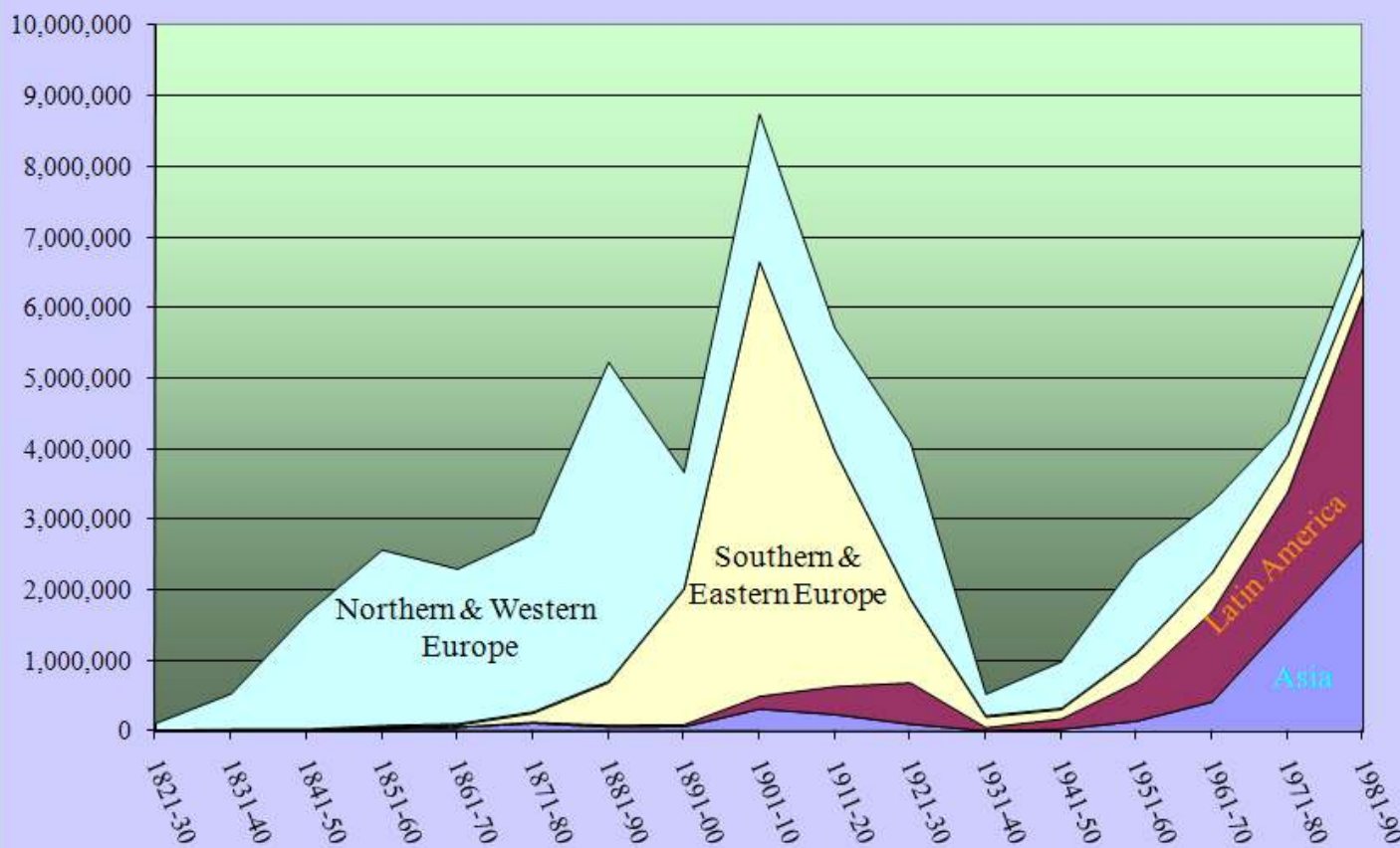

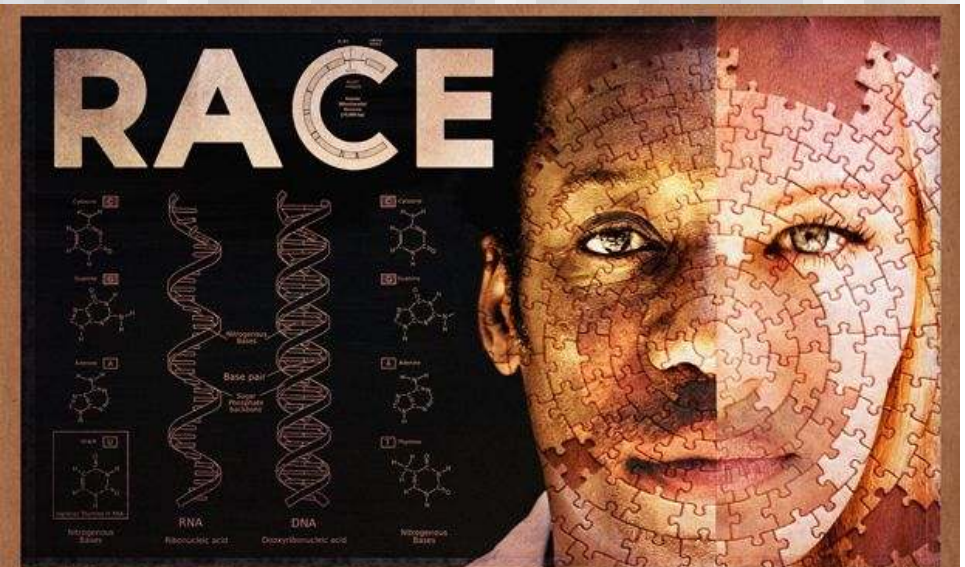

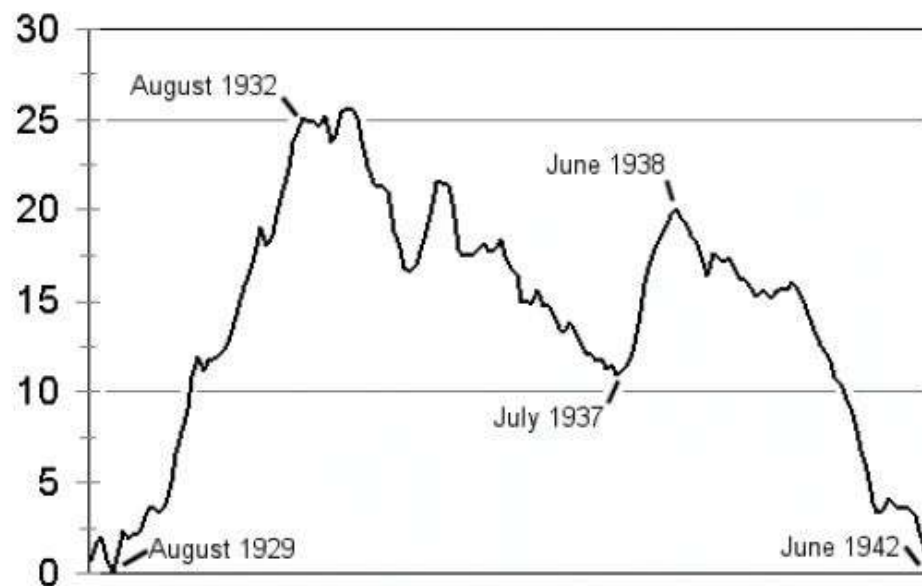

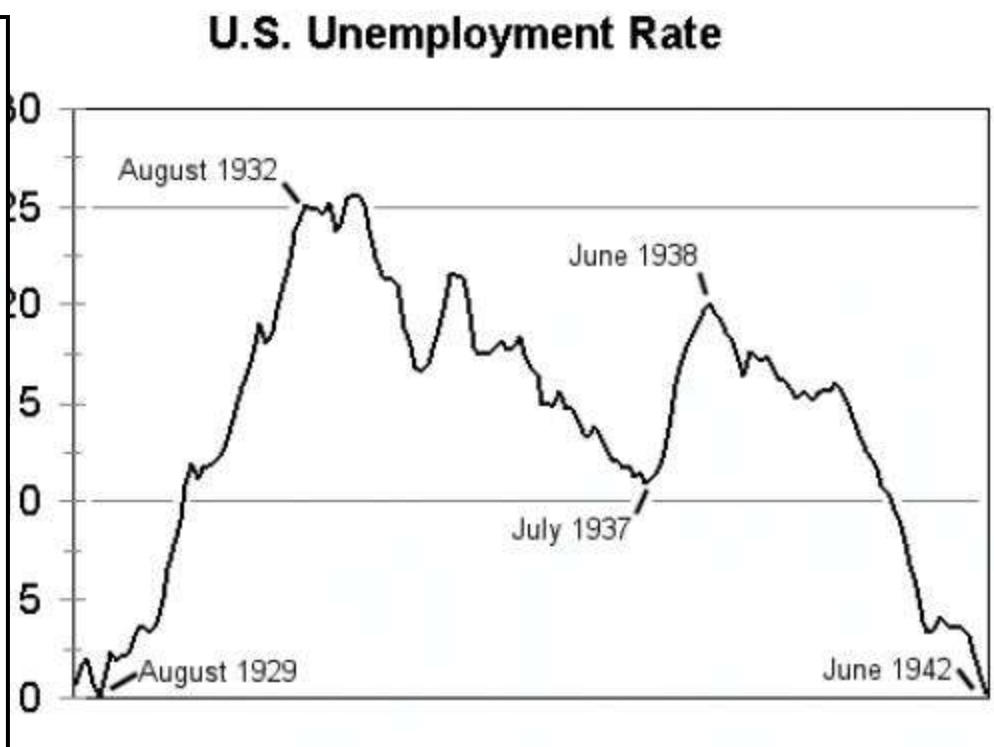
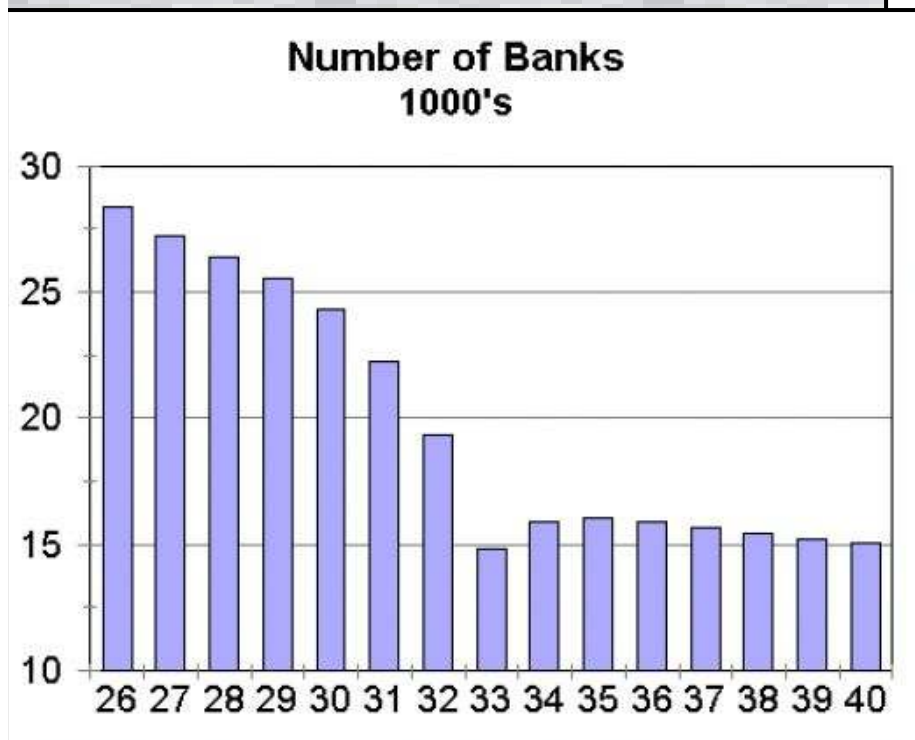


U.S. Unemployment Rate

(Panics of 1873, 1893, 1901, 1907, 1920)

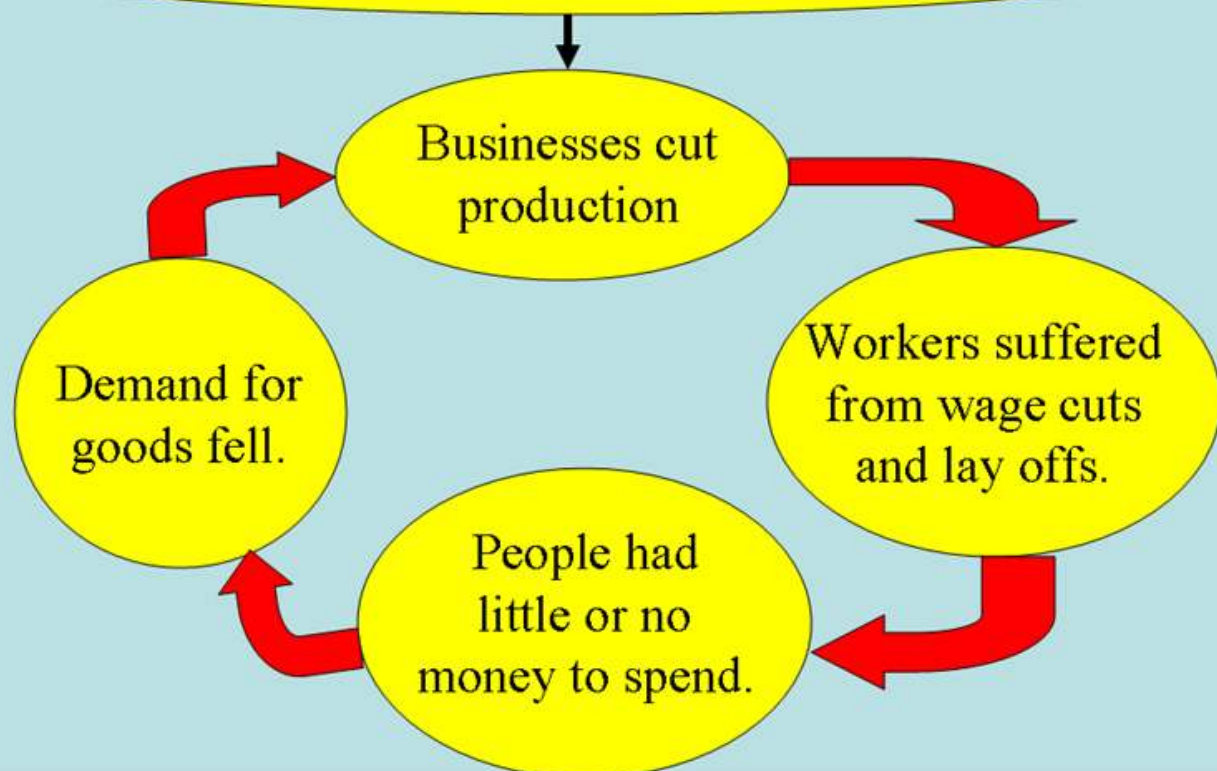
