In 1950, 17 states and DC had laws requiring segregated public schools

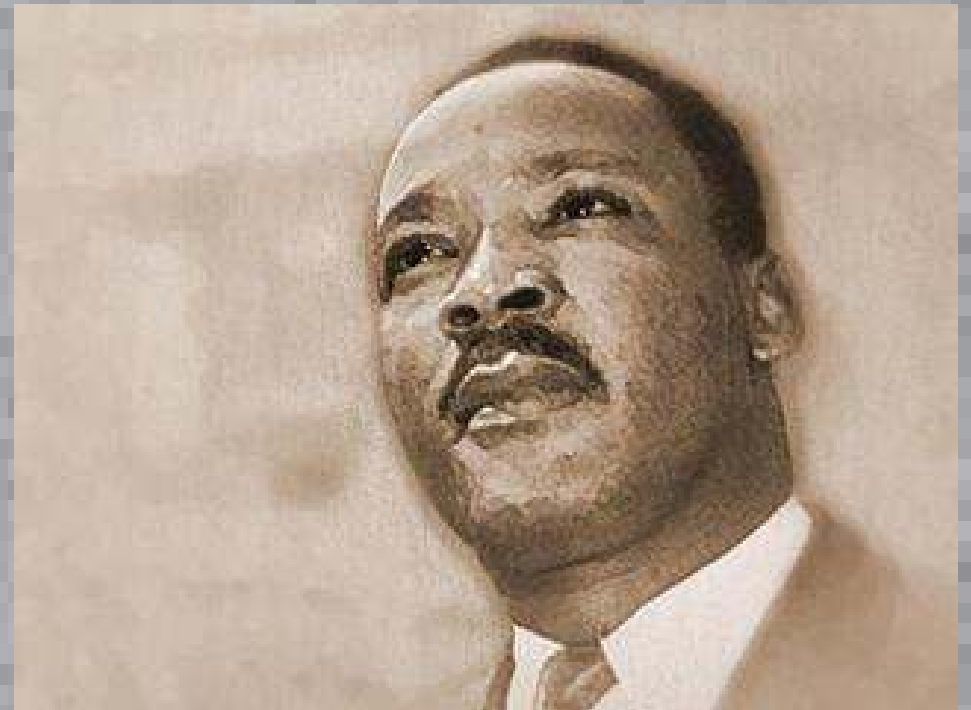
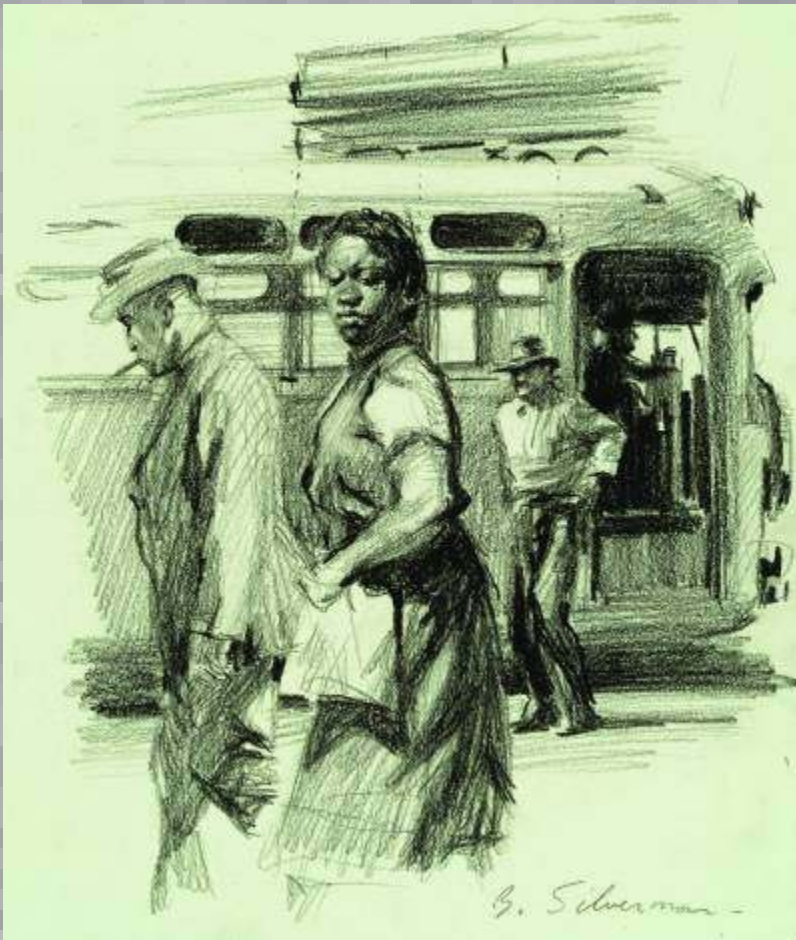


40% of students attended legally segregated schools.

Plus northern housing patterns created *de facto* segregation.

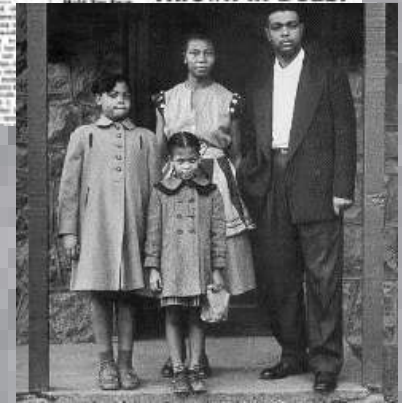

### ***Brown v. Board of Ed.*** **1954**

**Supreme Court rules on narrow points of law:**

**Did not address:**

**De facto school segregation**

**Interracial marriage**

**Segregation at places other than school**

**Topeka, Kansas**  
**“Separate not Equal”**  
**School funding**

won but board appealed

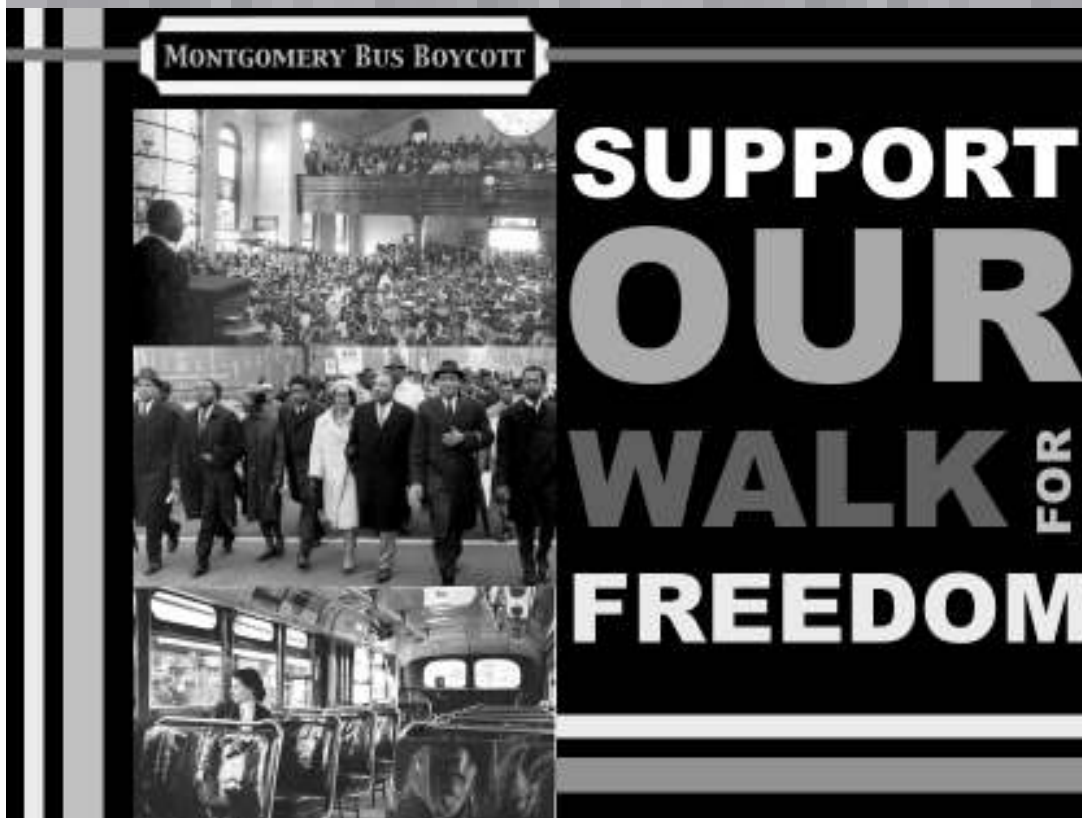
*Bolling v. Sharpe* (Washington DC)

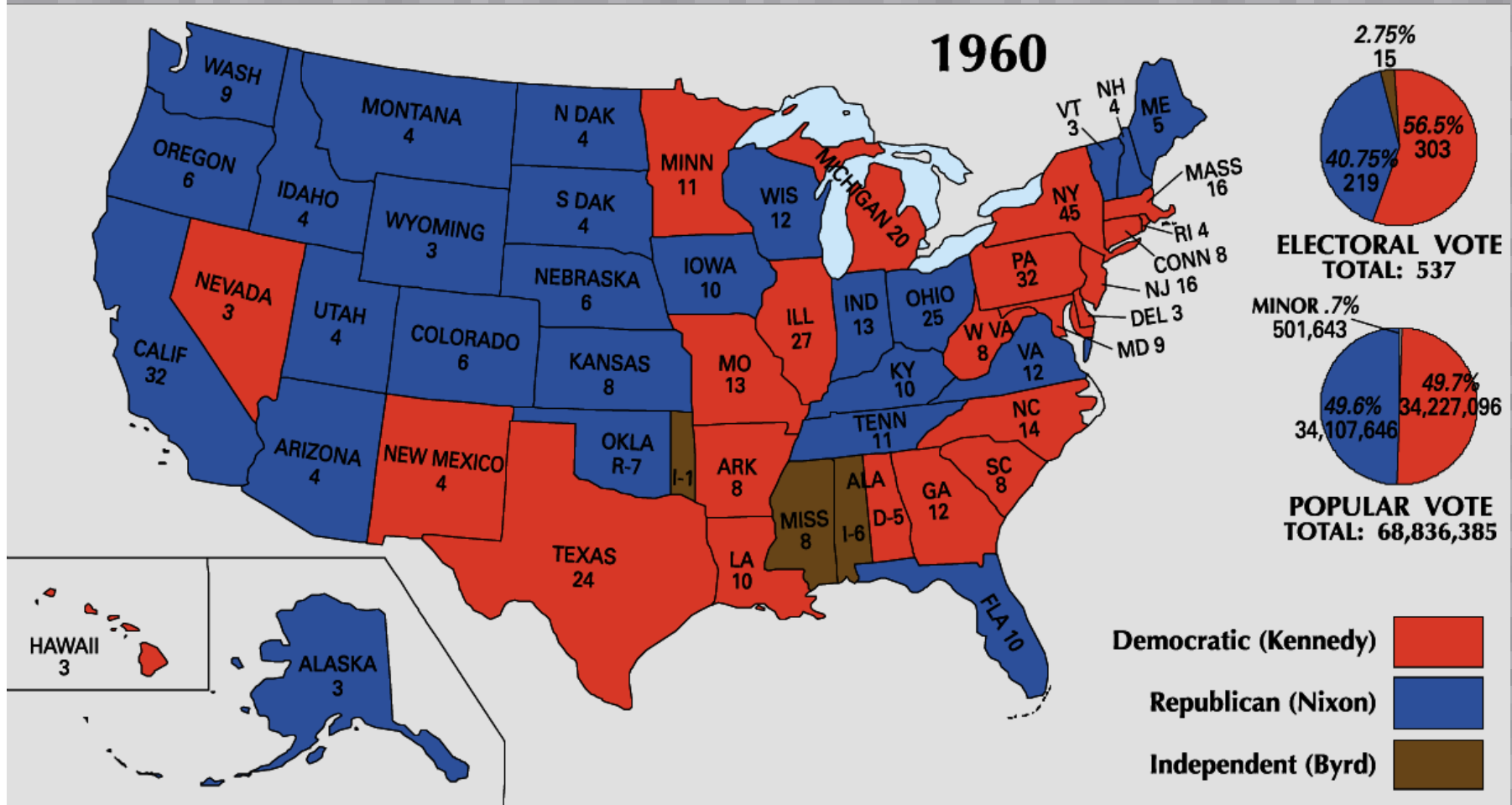
